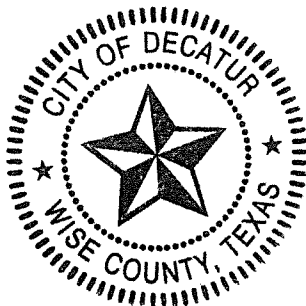




Council member Reeves moved to approve the consent agenda as presented. Council member Holloway seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
